Persatuan Kebajikan Kanak-kanak Rhema (Rhema Children Welfare Home) is a private nonprofit organization designed to give hope to orphans, homeless, abandoned and destitute children of Malaysia.

Children from the two orphanages will benefit from the sponsorship of three computers per home for their computer laboratory, allowing the children to be more computer savvy.

"The computer units are to help the children with their homework as well as for them to learn basic computer skills," said Lawrence Lee, Group Marketing Manager.

To date, Avillion Group of Hotels has embarked on a series of successful CSR programmes with both orphanages. "We all look forward to seeing the impact of the Computer Lab on the children, especially in this day and age of computers.
